1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The FIM promoter TTXGP will organize the **FIM eRoad Racing World Cup United States, on the Indianapolis Motor Speedway circuit, from 16th to 18th August 2013** counting towards the FIM eROAD RACING WORLD CUP IMN: **108/03**

3. CIRCUIT

The length of the circuit is **4.216 m**. All races will be run **anti-clockwise**. A drawing of the circuit is enclosed. The access to the Circuit will be authorized from Wednesday 14th August at 14h00.

4. CLASSES

Two wheeled electric propelled motorcycles, powered solely by stored electricity (battery/accumulator).

5. JURISDICTION

The meeting will be held in accordance with the FIM Sporting Code, the CCR Rules 2013 and these Supplementary Regulations. The organizer also commits to respect as much as possible the "Green line" charter of good practice.

8. ENTRIES, DEPOSIT

Applications for entry must be made on the official forms included with these regulations. Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach **TTXGP** not later than August 10th 2013, by midnight.

The organizer will select the applications and notify riders within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or rejected.

IMPORTANT: No transponder will be provided by the organizer. Each team will bring his own AMD transponder.

9. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

No rider or machine is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspections, which will be held according to the following schedule:

A compulsory briefing for all riders participating in the eRoad racing World Cup will take place on **Friday at 11'45 h.** at a location to be determined.

TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS **must be done before the Qualification Practice 1:**

10. PRACTICE SCHEDULE (subject to changes)

It is strictly forbidden to ride racing motorcycles on the course outside the official practice periods. The practice sessions will take place according to the following schedule:

16/08/13 (Friday)	Qualifying practice 1	17h05 to 17h25
17/08/13 (Saturday)	Qualifying practice 2	17h00 to 17h20

Minimum lap numbers to be qualified: 3



11. RACES: SCHEDULE (subject to changes)

Date of the start: **18 August 2013 (Sunday)**

Time: **16h30**

Distance: **8 laps**

To qualify for the race, a rider must achieve a time at least equal to the average of the best 3 times + 20% in at least one qualifying session (See Art. 1.11.3).
Note: The sighting lap is no longer applied (CCR Decision, May 2011).

According to Art. 1.14.13 of **FIM eRoad Racing World Cup**/E-power International Championship Regulations 2013, a red light will be displayed for between 2 and 5 seconds. The red light will go out to start the race.

12. PODIUM

For the riders placed in the first 3 positions in the race, directly after the race. Participation is compulsory (See Art. 1.24).

13. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the requirements of the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of **660 €**

14. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the FIM requirements.

In conformity with Article 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders covering accidents occurring during the meeting including practices will be the responsibility of the organiser.

This insurance includes a Third Party guarantee of a minimum of 3.000.000. €

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

15. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the FIM Sporting Code, riders and teams by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.

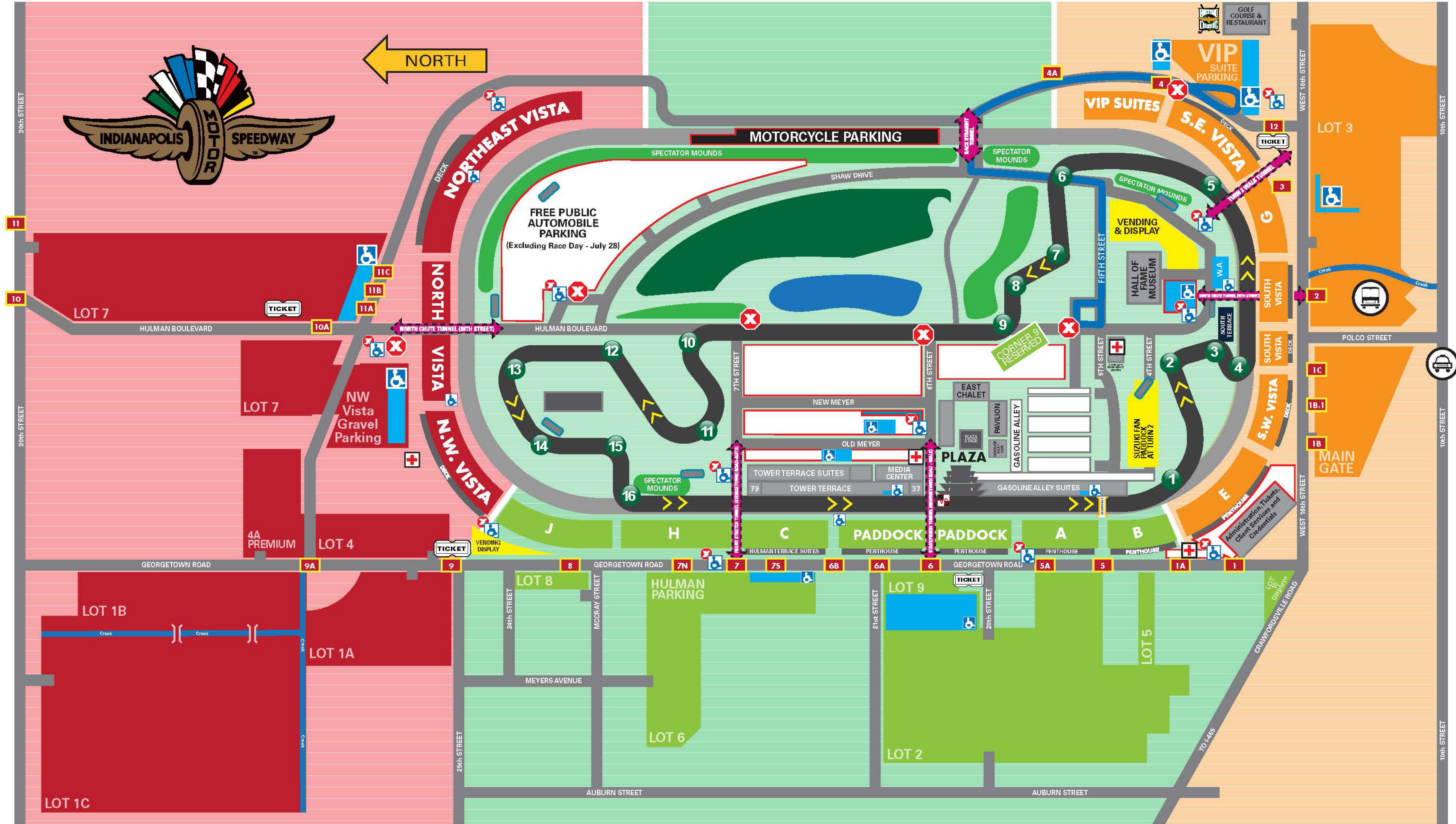
