FIM eRoad Racing World Cup Final round cancelled

It is with great regret that FIM and TTXGP announce the cancellation of the 2013 FIM eRoad Racing World Cup Final.

The final was originally set to take place in India this November as a support race for WSBK at the Buddh International Circuit. Unfortunately the WSBK Indian Round that was scheduled to take place on 17 November has been cancelled.

The cancellation meant TTXGP were forced to amend our calendar accordingly and find a new venue for the world final but time constraints made this task impossible.

Azhar Hussain, CEO of TTXGP, said: "The decision to cancel our world final was not one we have taken lightly. Unfortunately we have exhausted all our options to reschedule this event and have been left with no option but to cancel this year's final and concentrate on making 2014 our best season yet."

Without a Final for this World Cup, the FIM has had to take an extraordinary decision to establish two separate classifications with regard to the rounds in North America and the ones in Europe.

The FIM (Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme) founded in 1904, is the governing body for motorcycle sport and the global advocate for motorcycling. The FIM is an independent association formed by 108 National Federations throughout the world. It is recognised as the sole competent authority in motorcycle sport by the International Olympic Committee (IOC). Among its 50 FIM World Championships the main events are MotoGP, Superbike, Endurance, Motocross, Supercross, Trial, Enduro, Cross-Country Rallies and Speedway. Furthermore, the FIM is also active and involved in the following areas: public affairs, road safety, touring and protection of the environment. The FIM was the first international sports federation to impose an Environmental Code in 1994.
