Pursuant Art. 14.3.2 of the FIM Anti-Doping Rules

1. On 6 September 2025, a FIM Doping Control Officer collected a urine sample from Marc-Reiner Schmidt (the Rider) in an in-competition test during the 2025 FIM SuperMoto SGP1 World Championship in Busca (Italy).
2. The analysis of the A and B sample reported an Adverse Analytical Finding (AAF) for Cocaine, a Prohibited Substance of Abuse (S6 A: Non-Specified Stimulant) according to WADA's Prohibited List.
3. Upon receipt of the AAF, the FIM notified the Rider, and the latter submitted his explanations jointly with his evidence.
4. The Rider has formally admitted the anti-doping rule violation of Art. 2.1 and 2.2 of the FIM Anti-Doping Rules and accepted the applicable consequences and sanctions as determined under Art. 10.2.4.1 of the FIM Anti-Doping Rules.
5. In view of the out-of-competition use of the Prohibited Substance of Abuse the Rider is sanctioned with:
 - a) a period of ineligibility of 3 months starting from 21 November 2025 to 21 February 2026, and
 - b) disqualification of all competitive results obtained by the Rider from 6 September 2025 to the end of the 2025 FIM SuperMoto SGP1 World Championship.
6. Accordingly, the official Rankings of the 2025 FIM SuperMoto SGP1 World Championship and 2025 SuperMoto of Nations are updated as follows.
