TESTING

Riders are subject to random doping control tests, both in- and out-of-competition, conducted without prior notice at any location and time by any authorized anti-doping organization, including the FIM, National Anti-Doping Organizations (NADOs), or WADA.

"In-Competition" means the period after the rider has passed the technical and/or administrative scrutineering, whichever is the earlier, before a competition in which the rider is scheduled to participate through the end of such competition and the sample collection process related to such competition.

"Out-of-competition" is any time frame that falls outside of the "in-competition" period by default

Registered Testing Pools / Testing Pools and Whereabouts

In line with the World Anti-Doping Code and the FIM Anti-Doping rules, we ask riders to provide reliable information about their whereabouts to ensure an effective out-of-competition testing program. To achieve this, certain riders are chosen to submit precise details using the WADA online ADAMS System. Doping Control Officers rely on this information to find riders for out-of-competition testing. These riders are categorized into either a Testing Pool (TP) or a Registered Testing Pool (RTP). RTP riders have stricter whereabouts requirements, and there are more significant consequences for failing to meet these requirements.
