PROTESTS AND APPEAL

Any person or group of persons - rider, passenger, entrant, manufacturer, official, etc., recognized by the FIM and concerned by a decision taken under the authority of the FIM, has the right to protest against that decision before the International Jury, except in the case of statement of fact.

Protests against the eligibility of a rider, passenger, team or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the official practice.

Protests against results must be presented to the International Jury within 30 minutes following the publication of the results.

An appeal may be made against a decision of the International Jury to the International Disciplinary Court (CDI).

All protests to the International Jury must be made in accordance with the requirement of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code of the FIM and be accompanied by a fee of **660** Euros returnable if the protest is justified or forfeited if the Disciplinary body considers the protest to be groundless, or if it is withdrawn without a hearing.

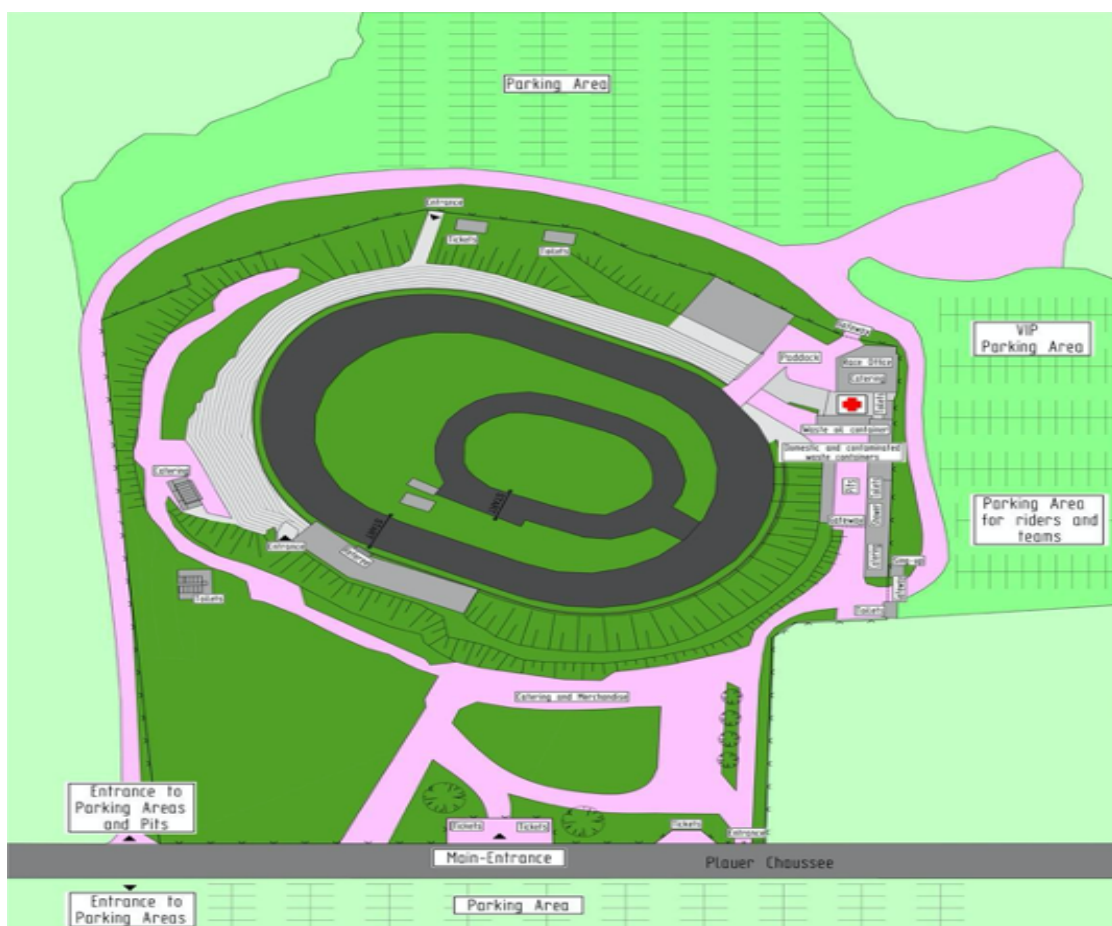
Environmental Management Map:

To support the Environmental Management Plan, organisers are required to provide a map of the venue showing clearly the location of the following facilities:

- a. Waste oil containers
- b. Bike washing area
- c. Domestic and contaminated waste containers
- d. Refuelling location
- e. Toilets and showers
- f. Disposal point for used tyres (if provided)

This document must be sent to the FIM Administration, through the National Federation, together with the Supplementary Regulations.

The map must be displayed in a visible place for participants and teams.



Speedway Arena Güstrow Environmental Management Plan

1. There is no Bike washing area around the arena. The nearest bike washing possibility is at 800 m distance at Total gas station.
2. There is no Disposal point for used tyres around the arena.
3. The Refuelling locations and the waste oil containers are located inside the paddock.
4. The fitting room, toilets and showers for all riders and their teams are located inside the paddock. For spectators there are sufficient toilets around the arena.
5. There are two big waste containers outside the arena and at each open entrances there are a trash-basket.
6. Inside the arena there are sufficient trash-baskets for the spectators.
