GENERAL INFORMATION



WHY A TROPHY?

With its **Trophy for the Future**, the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM) wishes to recognise and acknowledge those who have significantly:

- **Contributed** to improving and developing the presence of youngsters in all motorcycling-related areas
- **Raised** awareness among youngsters in motorcycling
- **Created** development plans for young riders.

The FIM is therefore pleased to call for nominations for this annual FIM Trophy for the Future.

WHO CAN APPLY?

This Trophy may be conferred on **individuals, groups or organisations** (e.g. CONUs, FMNs, clubs, organisers, promoters, circuit owners, manufacturers, teams etc.) who have made a significant contribution to enhancing awareness among youngsters or who have implemented projects/initiatives to improve the presence of young riders in all motorcycling-related activities.

These projects, initiatives or contributions can be related to **sporting or non-sporting** activities and should be in alignment with FIM Development Programmes. They should provide **mid- or long-term solutions** to help develop the presence of youngsters in all motorcycling-related activities and have lasting effects and impacts on the awareness of youngsters.

PRACTICAL ASPECTS

The Trophy may be granted for a single project, activity or initiative over the period **1 September 2021 to 31 August 2022**. Nominations may be submitted by a FMN, the person(s) involved in the activity or by a third party. Please note that FIM Staff members and/or FIM Commissions members are not eligible for this Trophy.

Examples of initiatives in line with the FIM Development Programme which would be eligible for the FIM Trophy for the Future:

- Covering youngsters' activities and achievements in the media in an effective manner
- Suggesting simple and effective ideas to encourage greater participation by youngsters in all FIM activities
- Providing competitive opportunities for youngsters at national, continental or international level
- Promoting youngsters role models and developing mentoring programs
- Etc.



In concrete terms:

- Increasing the sporting level of youngsters competing in all disciplines
- Creating new competitions/classes for youngsters
- Increasing the number of youngsters serving as volunteers
- Organising of training camps or seminars for young riders
- Innovations from industry/manufacturers dedicated to youngsters
- Safety work focusing on youngsters
- Etc.

HOW TO APPLY?

Candidatures must be in **English only** and should be submitted as soon as possible, but no later than **31 August 2022**.

All candidatures must be submitted through the **dedicated online application form** by clicking: **HERE**

Candidates may, if they wish, send additional supporting documents (i.e. selection of pictures or videos, reference letters, relevant press release...) directly by email to **recognition@fim.ch**.

The FIM reserves its right not to award the prize if no suitable candidatures are received.

THE JURY

All candidatures will be examined by an **independent jury** composed of a Member of the FIM Awards and Recognition Committee, the FIM Sports Director and two independent experts appointed by the FIM. The Jury will first shortlist **three candidatures** – which will be published on the FIM website and Social Network pages. The Jury will then choose the winner among those three candidatures.

Any conflicts of interest must be declared at the beginning of the process.

AWARD OF THE TROPHY

The awardee may be invited to the annual FIM Awards Prize Giving Ceremony and may receive the Trophy on stage. The winner will have the privilege to use the FIM “Trophy for the Future” **logo** on all its related communications (print, web etc.).
