All Team Entries (TDN / WTDN) should be made at least 60 days before the Event so by **Wednesday 12 July included**. If necessary, entries can be made without the riders' names.

All entries made between 60 days, **Thursday 13 July** and 30 days, **Wednesday 09 August** before the Event, will see their fees increased by an administration fee of 150€.

Entries will close 30 days before on **Thursday 10 August**.

All riders names should have been included by closing of the entries on Thursday 10 August.
