#### **4. ENTRIES:**

Riders wishing to participate in the Monster Energy Enduro del Verano FIM Sand Races World Cup must send a registration form (available on Sportity app, on the FIM Sand Races channel and send it to FIM and register at <https://endurodelverano.com.ar/inscripcion.html>

Sportity app is downloadable for iOS devices on Appstore and for Android devices on Google Play. Channel password is "FIMSandRaces".

Please note, that only the participants who send Entry Form to the FIM and paid their entry fee directly to the organiser.

Registration requests will only be accepted and effective if the registration fee is paid.  
Registration fee: 250 Us dollars.

Open date of entries: 1 December

Closing date of entries for foreign riders: 18 February

#### **5. WITHDRAWAL – CANCELLATION**

Only withdrawals registered on the site until 20th of February 2024 will be eligible for a refund of the registration fee. Administrative fees could be deducted.

After this date, no refunds will be made for any reason including force majeure.  
Only exception: decease of a first-degree relative with supporting documents.

Cancellation of Enduro del Verano for any reason without exception, refusal and/or withdrawal of national/police authorisations or access authorisation, political unrest, financial difficulties and weather conditions which prevent the organisation of the event are considered as a case of force majeure.

In such cases, nor organizer is not liable for refunds or compensation of any nature.

## 8. ACCREDITATIONS

Passes and wristbands can be collected at the administrative checks located at “INSCRIPCION” box on track place. Will receive one for rider and one for mechanic.

The pass must be stuck on the windscreen and the wristband and fastened tightly on the rider’s wrist for access to the rider’s area.

No additional wristbands will be provided for the participant’s team.

## 9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

**Location: "Inscripcion" tent on track**

Plates are provided by the organisers.

**During Administrative Checks Participants must present the following documents:**

- 1) ID card or Passport
- 2) 2024 FIM Sand Races World Cup valid one event or annual licence or any annual valid FIM Licence as per the validity chart delivered by their national federation
- 3) For Juniors categories – parental autorisation

Only originals will be accepted. Declarations of loss or theft and photocopies will not be accepted.

**10. TECHNICAL CHECKS**

The Technical check will be located at: "Técnica" tent at track.

- Stands

Motorcycles must be fitted with an adjustable stand for technical checks in the rider's area. Adjustable stands must then be removed for the race.

An on-board camera is not allowed during the entire event, from the practice sessions until the end of the event.

**11. PLATES**

Each Race participant will need to bring their proper Plates according the standards detailed in the Art. 01.55; 55.07; 55.12 of the FIM Technical Sand Regulations.

**12. RACE ORGANISATION****Convoy:**

Any rider found to be forcing their way or considered to be driving dangerously to change their start position will be immediately sanctioned by Clerk of the Course.

**Race Format:****1. Sprint Race: Saturday 12:30 h.**

20 minutes in a third part length of the track.

Track length: 3,5 km

Table score defined by FIM rules

**2. Main Race: Sunday 14.30h.**

45 minutes in the original track

Track length: 12,5 km

Table score defined by FIM rules

Start: 15 lines each with 30 motorcycles per line by race number. Solo riders leave before two-rider teams.

Rider are on the quad bike with the motor running. The first line starts when the race manager gives the signal.

The Clerk of the Course or the Start Marshal advances to the second line after the start of the first line, the signal for the start of the second line is given, and so on for all the lines.

### **13. CIRCUIT**

Saturday 24 February

The Enduro del Verano Circuit is 3.5 km long for the motorcycles and quads.

Sunday 25 February

The Enduro del Verano Circuit is 12.5 km long for the motorcycles and quads.

### **14. TIMEKEEPING**

Timekeepers count the number of laps completed by each participant. The final classification is calculated with the number of complete laps and the order of arrival at the finish line. The tracking unit mounted on the motorcycle is obligatory during the entire race for the selected participants. The tracking unit must be returned at the end of the race.

### **15. END OF THE RACE**

Unless exceptional circumstances, the race is over when the leading participant passes the finish line at the end of the 6<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> lap. A Parc Fermé will be assigned for participants after each race.

Classification will be decided as each participant passes the finish line.

After the race, rider must return to the Assistance area.

### **16. ENVIRONMENT**

Riders are requested to strictly respect the FIM Environmental Code and FIM Sand Races World Cup Regulations.

Tear-off films for goggles are strictly forbidden.

Riders leaving waste in the public area will be penalised.

Use of the environmental mat is obligatory as per Art. 4.1 of the FIM Environmental Code.

### **17. REFUELLING/PIT STOP AREA/ASSISTANCE**

After the beginning of the race, assistance can only be provided in the pit stop Areas created for this purpose.

Max.1 assistants by a rider are authorised to access the pit stop with their equipment:

fire extinguisher and garage mat in compliance with FIM Regulations and jerrycans max.20 litres.

Speed limit in the area is 20km/h. Speeding will be penalised by a time or financial fine upon decision of the Clerk of the Course.

Participants must have a verified fire extinguisher in compliance with standards on their stand, for which they are responsible.

Access to the Pit Stop Area is not authorised for minors under 16, bikes and animals.

This procedure aims to reduce the number of people in the pit stop Area and ensure safety conditions for participants.

People in the Pit Stop Area who do not wear a wristband issued by the organisers will be removed. Refusal may lead to disqualification of the assisted rider(s).

It is forbidden to move material out from the Pit Stop Area during the race.

Fuel tank: Max. 12 litres for fuel tanks in the motorcycle category.

### **Signholder zones**

Signholder zones are indicated along the Pit Stop area. Only signholders with signs are authorised in this area. Access to these areas is limited to people with a wristband.

The public does not have access to these areas. Refusal may lead to disqualification of the assisted rider(s).

Wristbands are only valid for the race in question.

## **18. ADVERTISING**

Plates must not be cut or modified.

Riders who cover, cut and/or modify organiser advertising (plate) will not be authorised to start the race.

plates will be checked by stewards at the entrance to the riders area.

Any promotional, advertising or public relations operation of any nature during or referring to the race, including the use of films, videos and photos for commercial or similar purposes requires previous written authorisation from the organiser and is subject to duties payable to the organiser and prosecution.

Use of images by any means and on any media during the race is strictly forbidden, including for non-commercial use, without prior authorisation from the organiser. Non compliance with this regulation will lead to legal proceedings.

Participants expressly accept that the organisation or delegated third-parties use and broadcast their image or images featuring them, photos, videos, TV programmes, on all medias and all by-products and by terrestrial and cable TV (cable, FTTx, ADSL), satellite,

IPTV and on social media, mobile networks and any other means or media chosen by the Organiser such as VOD, Replay, regardless of the terminals used for viewing, standards allowing broadcast of still or moving images and the functionalities of any access control systems used.

Nor the Organisers nor FIM responsible for loss of on-board cameras or any other equipment on the circuit during the race.

## **19. CLASSIFICATION**
