New licensing system for Technical Stewards and Senior Technical Stewards

Dear FMNs & CONUs,

The CTI and the FIM Academy are pleased to announce a revamped seminar system designed to provide more comprehensive and precise training for Technical Stewards and Senior Technical Stewards.

The technical development of officials is a top priority for the FIM. This significant enhancement in the CTI seminars will provide National Federations (FMNs) with invaluable opportunities to improve their technical competencies, operational standards, and innovation capabilities. By offering structured training sessions and updated resources, the FIM aims to elevate the skill levels of FMN officials and technical staff, enabling them to better meet the demands of international motorsport events.

Through these seminars, FMNs will not only gain access to the latest knowledge in technical regulations, safety standards, and team management but also benefit from hands-on workshops, expert-led discussions, and peer networking. This initiative underscores the FIM's commitment to building a well-trained and knowledgeable global network of technical personnel, ultimately contributing to the growth and integrity of the sport.

The new seminar system will introduce several key enhancements:

1. **Level 1 Seminar for Technical Stewards:** A dedicated seminar featuring a tailored curriculum and hands-on training specifically for Technical Stewards, designed to meet their unique needs and foundational responsibilities.
2. **Level 2 Seminars for Senior Technical Stewards / All disciplines / Circuit-Racing / Off-Road:** Two specialized seminars at Level 2, each focusing on a different discipline, Off-Road and Circuit Racing. These seminars are expressly designed for Experts and Senior Technical

Stewards who hold advanced roles and responsibilities, providing in-depth knowledge and skills relevant to their specific areas of expertise.

This updated structure aims to provide all Technical and Senior Technical Stewards with targeted, role-specific training, thereby fostering higher standards and expertise across all disciplines. Here are further details:

Level 1 - Seminar for Technical Stewards

- Target: newcomers and renewal of Technical Stewards licences
- Language: expected basic spoken and written English level
- Curriculum:
 - Practical training of basic technical checks for all disciplines
 - Theory and Practice
 - E-Bike
 - Rider's equipment check
 - Safety and engine checks
- Organisation: organised and requested by FMNs with FIM Instructor – as in the past
- Duration: 1.5 days
- Licence obtained: FIM Technical Steward
- Validity: 3 years
- Benefits: This seminar will provide newcomers with more foundational training than in the past, allowing additional time for practice and hands-on learning. National Federations can also use this seminar as a certification pathway for their national Technical Stewards.

Level 2 - Seminar for Senior Technical Stewards

- Target: Experts and Senior Technical Stewards of World Championships
- Language: expected fluent spoken and written English
- Curriculum:
 - Technical Reports
 - Team Management
 - High level technical checks
- Organisation: The seminar will be held annually at the FIM Tech Lab, located at FIM Headquarters.
- Duration: 1 day Off-Road, 1 day Circuit Racing – The seminars are scheduled back-to-back, allowing participants to attend both sessions, if so needed, and achieve the FIM Senior Technical Steward All Disciplines.
- Licence obtained: FIM Senior Technical Steward Off-Road or Track Racing, FIM Senior Technical Steward Circuit Racing or FIM Senior Technical Steward All Disciplines
- Validity: 3 years

Benefits: This seminar is designed for highly experienced Technical Stewards and will focus on advanced topics, including leadership and team management. It will provide an opportunity for participants to share experiences with colleagues and gain insights from experts in each discipline.

The inaugural "Level 2" seminars will be held at the FIM Headquarters as part of the FIM Commission Conference, scheduled as follows:

- **February 6, 2025:** Off-Road seminar, with the exam scheduled for **February 7, 2025**
- **February 7, 2025:** Circuit Racing seminar, with the exam taking place on the same day.

We kindly invite you to register your FIM Senior Technical Stewards and FIM Technical Stewards who need to renew their licenses in 2025, and you National Technical Stewards/Leaders who wish to obtain for the first time the FIM Technical Stewards Licence once registration opens on the FIM Extranet platform.
